## Re: Draft South Coast Designated Maritime Area Plan for Offshore Renewable Energy Workbook 1-Draft Environmental Data Log("the Data Log").

The consultation body comprising of The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs Northern Ireland (DAERA) and (supported with a service level agreement) DfC Historic Environment Division (HED), has considered the consultation and associated documents and our opinions are set out below.

## **General SEA Comments**

DAERA welcomes the opportunity to comment on the document entitled "Workbook 1-Draft Environmental Data Log" ("the Data Log"). We would highlight that in addition to any new comments provided in this response our previous response dated 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024 still stands.

## **Marine and Fisheries Division Comments**

DAERA Marine and Fisheries Division welcomes the opportunity to comment on this consultation. The boundary of the project area lies just under 200km from NI waters, and ~230km to the North Channel SAC (designated for Harbour Porpoise). This is outside the screening ranges used for Harbour Porpoise – all SACs within 100km of the project should be screened in- therefore we are unlikely to have any concerns.

We would highlight, however, in the Draft South Coast Designated Maritime Plan for Offshore Renewable Energy document they refer to 'the Northern Ireland Environment Agency, Wind Sustainability at the heart of a living, working, active landscape valued by everyone.
