# **Specific Purpose:**

These subsets of forms are submitted to the Irish Maritime Administration within the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport where it is processed and kept on file.

## **Legal Basis:**

The legal basis for the collected of data is in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation Article 6.1(d) (a) the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes, (b) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to

entering into a contract (d)Processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person.
