

## Marine Notice No.10 of 2020

Notice to Port Authorities, Port Security Officers and Port Facility Security Officers, Recognised Security Organisations (Ports)

## Updated Templates for Port Facility Security Plan & Port Security Plans 2019 – 2024.

The Department wishes to advise that updated templates for the above security plans are available in the attached links.

The PFSP template should be used for:

- "Article 2.4 Single Facility" Ports where an approved assessment confirms that the boundaries of the Port and the Facility are the same. These facilities will continue to be subject to the requirements of the Regulation only (as per Art 2.4 of Directive 2005/65/EC) and will only require a Port Facility Security Plan;
- 2. Individual Port Facilities in multi-facility ports.

The "Combined" Port Security Plan template is for single facility ports where Art. 2.4 does not apply and which includes the requirements of both the EU Regulation 725/2004/EC and the EU Directive 2005/65/EC.

The Over Arching Port Security Plan template is only intended for use by multi-facility ports.
