<b>Balder</b>	26/06/2020	Grand Canal Basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knots. Sea state not exceeding 300mm.
<b>Banrion Na Farraigne</b>	06/04/2020	Between Rossaveal, Co. Galway to the Aran Islands Co. Galway.
<b>Boy Colm</b>	24/06/2020	Between Schull, Long Island, Baltimore, Heir Island, Sherkin & Cape Clear.
<b>Carrigloe</b>	07/07/2020	Carrigaloe to Glenbrook. Permitted to load and discharge at Spike Island subject to specified conditions: See Conditions below

<b>Clew Bay Queen</b>	22/04/2020	Voyages between Roonagh and Clare Island, Inisturk, Inishbofin, Cloughmore, Cleggan Old Head and Rosmoney in daylight only & good visibility. See also "Conditions and Restrictions" below for more details
<b>Connemara Lady</b>	08/06/2020	Killary Harbour, inside Inisbarna Island, embarking and disembarking at Nancy's Point.
<b>Corrib Queen</b>	13/05/2020	Lough Corrib during daylight hours in fine and favourable weather.
<b>Dun Aengus</b>	20/05/2020	Baltimore, Sherkin Island - Abbey Strand Jetty, Schull, North harbour, Cape Clear.
<b>Frazer Mariner</b>	22/10/2020	In Summer: Inside of a line joining Cranfeld Point and Ballagan Point In Winter: In favourable weather only, within a line drawn from Greenore and Greencastle (Co. Down) points to a boundary line drawn from Soldiers Point at 245° to charted ruins at Ballytrasna Greencastle (Co. Donegal) to Magilligan (all year)
<b>Frazer Tintern</b>	29/05/2020	Between Passage East and Ballyhack

<b>Freya</b>	24/05/2020	Grand Canal basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knots. Sea state not exceeding 300mm.
<b>Glenbrook</b>	22/07/2020	Carrigaloe to Glenbrook as Passenger Ro-Ro ferry service. Ringaskiddy Pier to Spike Island for carriage of cargo not to exceed the max loading conditions of vessel's stability book and with no more than 12 passengers.
<b>Grainne Rose</b>	29/05/2020	Dunlewey Lough Co Donegal, in daylight hours with calm, clear, favourable conditions..
<b>Harbour Queen</b>	06/05/2020	From Bantry or Glengarriff. Within a line joining Four Heads Point & Whiddy Point East and inside Whiddy Island.
<b>Ikom K</b>	04/04/2020	Between Rerrin or Trá Glabhaldá slipways, Bere Island and Beal Lough or Castletownbere slipways
<b>Jack B</b>	24/05/2020	Departure Points: Liscannor, Doolin, Aran Islands; no more than 3 miles to sea or 15 miles from departure point. The vessel is not allowed operate within 0.5 miles of the Cliffs of Moher or other prominent headland.
<b>Karycraft</b>	12/05/2020	Within smooth waters of Cork Harbour only, within a line extending from Camden and Carlisle Forst
<b>Lady Laura</b>	12/06/2020	Smooth waters of Dingle Harbour - within a line joining Flaherty Point and Black Point
<b>Lantern II</b>	28/05/2020	Whiddy to Bantry.
<b>Liffey Ferry II</b>	15/09/2020	Dublin Port - voyages in the section of river between the East Link Bridge and The Samuel Beckett Bridge. Passengers may be embarked and disembarked only at the pontoons on the North Wall Quay and Sir John Rodgerson's Quay.
<b>Loki</b>	15/05/2020	Grand Canal basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knots. Sea state not exceeding 300mm.

<b>M V Coll</b>	09/04/2020	Burtonport to Aranmore Island, and Magheroarty or Curran Port to Innisboffin and Tory Island in favourable weather.

<b>Mary Fitzgerald</b>	17/04/2020	Between Balinakill and Waterford Castle island
<b>MV Cadhla</b>	08/06/2020	Mode A - Grand Canal between the railway bridge at Grand Canal Dock station and 19th lock at Robertstown (Mode B - Grand Canal Basin bounded by the railway bridge at Grand Canal Dock station and Camden Lock) SUSPENDED
<b>Mystic Waters</b>	03/10/2020	In Baltimore Harbour inside lines drawn between the following points. Beacon point and Barrack point and from Long Point to Deelish rock and from there to Frolic Point.
<b>Naomh Ciaran II</b>	13/05/2020	Between Roonagh and Inishturk, Clare Island, Achill, Old Head, Rosmoney and Westport Between Cleggan and Innisboffin.
<b>Odin</b>	03/04/2020	Grand Canal basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knots. Sea state not exceeding 300mm.
<b>Oilean Na Hoige</b>	22/05/2020	From slipway Castletownbere or Beal Logh (pontoon) to Bere Island - Oilean na gCaorach Rerrin or Trá Gabhalda slipways
<b>Pirate Queen</b>	24/11/2020	From Westport, Roonagh Quay, Cloughmore, and Cleggan to Clare Island, Innisboffin, Rosmoney and Inishturk. Old Head. Doolin Pier, to Aran Islands and Rossaveal
<b>Rhum</b>	20/11/2020	Burtonport to Aranmore Island, Magheroarty and Tory Island.
<b>Riasc</b>	10/06/2020	Grand Canal upstream from Barrow Street Bridge to the 19th lock, Lowtown Harbour. Generally less than 1.5 metres water depth
<b>Sancta Maria</b>	01/08/2020	From Slipway Castletownbere or Beal Logh (Pontoon) to Bere Island - Oilean na gCaorach Rerrin

<b>Sea Sprinter</b>	10/04/2020	Roonagh & Clare Island, Inisturk, Inishbofin, Cloughmore, Cleggan, Old Head and Rosmoney. In fine and favourable weather, during the hours of daylight only.
<b>Shannon Breeze</b>	25/05/2020	Between Killimer and Tarbert
<b>Shannon Dolphin</b>	17/04/2020	Between Killimer and Tarbert
<b>Spiorad Naomh Padraig</b>	01/05/2020	Within a line from Murrisk pier to Inishgort Light during the hours of daylight and in favourable weather.
<b>Spirit of Killaloe</b>	27/05/2020	Lough Derg, north of Killaloe Bridge in daylight hours only and in fine and favourable weather
<b>Spirit of Kinsale</b>	18/06/2020	Within a line from Blockhouse Point and Summer Cove in daylight hours. Within a line from Moneypoint to Carrigarone in favourable weather condition and daylight hours.
<b>St Columba</b>	14/11/2020	Lough Derg, St Patricks Purgatory, to and from Station Island in settled favourable weather. Vessel may operate during the hours of darkness between the approved piers, only when all pier markers are clearly visible
<b>St Davog</b>	14/11/2020	Lough Derg, St Patrick's, to and from Station Island in favourable weather and daylight hours only.
<b>Suaimhneas</b>	13/06/2020	No more than 3 miles from land and 15 miles from P.O.D. Ventry, Dingle and Dunquin
<b>Thor</b>	26/05/2020	Grand Canal Basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knot. Sea state not exceeding 300mm
<b>Tyr</b>	26/06/2020	Grand Canal Basin between sunrise and sunset. Wind not exceeding 25 knot. Sea state not exceeding 300 mm
<b>Yoker Swan</b>	04/04/2020	Between Baltimore and Sherkin Island.
