



## Update on Payments Awarded for Covid-19 Pandemic Unemployment Payment And Enhanced Illness Benefit - Statistics

**Published on Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2020 – these statistics are provisional and will be revised.**

### Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments

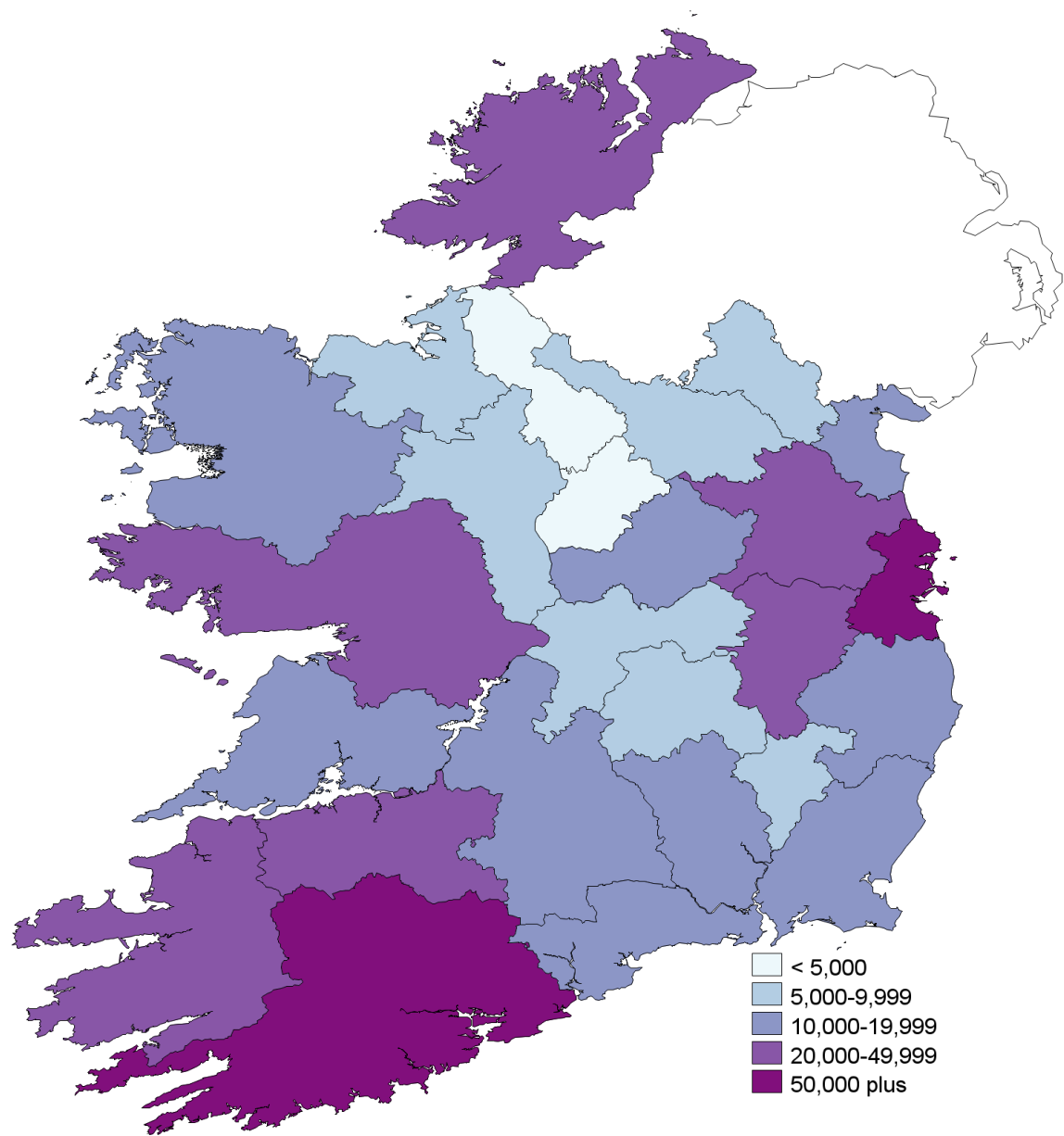
There are 543,200 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 246,800 are female and 296,400 are male.

A total of 682,400 people have received at least one payment since the scheme started.

## Pandemic Unemployment Payments - Sector Breakdown

The highest sector with people in receipt of the Pandemic Unemployment Payment is Accommodation and Food Service activities (122,200), followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade (80,900) and Construction (60,800).

The largest weekly drop was in Construction (14,100).
