**Published on Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – these statistics are provisional and will be revised.**

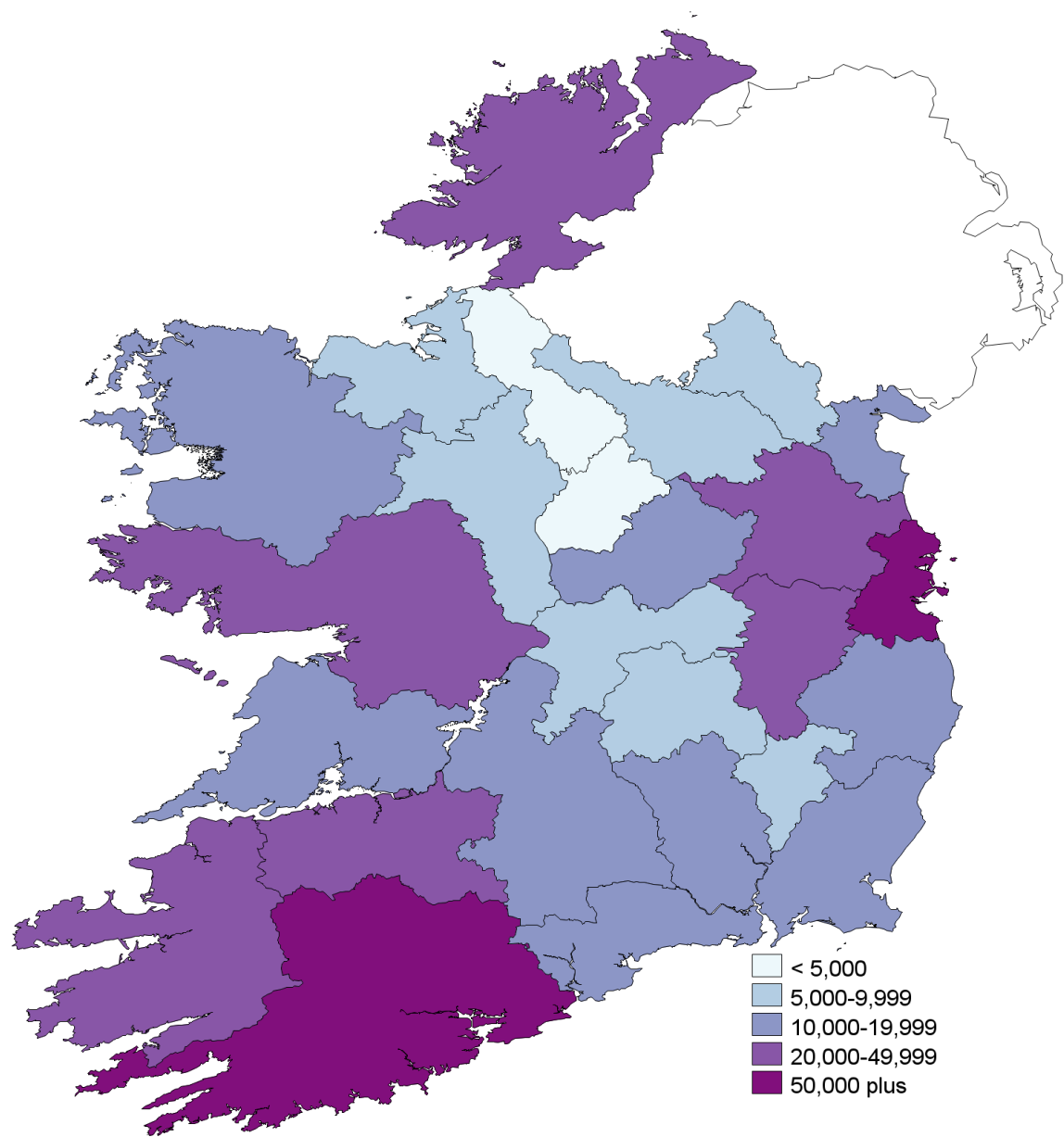
### Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments

There are 515,700 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 241,500 are female and 274,200 are male.

## Pandemic Unemployment Payments - Sector Breakdown

The highest sector with people in receipt of the Pandemic Unemployment Payment is Accommodation and Food Service activities (119,800), followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade (76,600) and Construction (51,400).

The largest weekly drop was in Construction (9,400).

## Analysis of COVID-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit

There are 48,900 people medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment of which 27,500 are female and 21,400 are male.

For 27,200 of these, the date of their first certificate was issued before week ending 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020. The following table shows the number of people medically certified for meeting the conditions for receipt of a Covid-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit payment, by start date entered on the medical certificate.
