4. What, if any, observations do you have regarding the High Speed Broadband Map Process?

It is unclear what the question is here however as I cannot find anywhere to express my difficulties regarding limited internet access I will avail of this facility to do so. I note that Eir has undertaken to provide commercial rural deployment plans and in my area Clane/Prosperous & north Co Kildare, there appears to be significant commitment to this apart from the Prosperous area where there are no such schemes. My road, the L6002 from Prosperous to Landenstown Bridge has over 52 premises many of which involve commercial activity as well as being residences yet have to endure a third world standard of unreliable internet services despite being 30 km from O' Connell Street. Where there is an established fibre infrastructure in place as in most north Kildare towns, providers should be strongly pushed to extend these services on roadways within at least a 5 km radius. Rural Ireland is not just confined to the far flung extremes of the country and I fear that to quench the grumblings of "Healy-Rea" type politics priority in this scheme will be given to the peripheral extremes of the State at the expense of those within the rural greater Dublin area..
