Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments


There are 465,900 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 224,800 are female and 241,100 are male.

A total of 693,800 people have received at least one payment since the scheme started.

Pandemic Unemployment Payments - Sector Breakdown

The highest sector with people in receipt of the Pandemic Unemployment Payment is Accommodation and Food service activities (114,600), followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade (63,600) and Construction (39,700).

The largest weekly drop was in Wholesale and Retail Trade (9,600).

Analysis of COVID-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit

There are 51,600 people medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment of which 29,100 are female and 22,500 are male.

For 27,700 of these, the date of their first certificate was issued before week ending 29th March 2020. The following Table shows the number of people medically certified for meeting the conditions for receipt of a Covid-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit payment, by start date entered on the medical certificate.
