Notice of AA Screening Determination

Application from CNOOC Petroleum Europe Ltd. to drill a single exploration well in the Iolar prospect under Frontier Exploration Licence (FEL) 3/18 in the Porcupine Basin offshore of the south west of Ireland.

The application is to drill a single exploration well to gather data on the reservoir characteristics, hydrocarbon presence, pressure and temperatures. This information will inform any future development and abandoned, whether well will be permanently plugged and abandoned, whether or not commercially viable quantities of hydrocarbons are found. The application was submitted by CNOOC Petroleum Europe Ltd on the 14th November, 2018 to the Department of Communications, Climate Action and Environment and was accompanied by an Environmental Risk Assessment (EIA Screening) and a Natura Impact Screening Statement (Appropriate Assessment Stage 1).

The application was assessed under the requirements of Article 6(3) of Directive (92/43/EEC) (as amended); the 'Habitats Directive' and Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 477 of 2011) (as amended); the 'Birds and Habitats Regulations'. Based on a review of the information provided in the application it was concluded that in the absence of the mitigation measures proposed by the applicant, the possibility of a likely significant effect on the site concerned cannot be excluded on the basis of objective scientific information.

Therefore it was concluded that a Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment (Natura Impact Statement) within the meaning of Article 6(3) of Directive (92/43/EEC) (as amended); the 'Habitats Directive' and Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 477 of 2011) (as amended); the 'Birds and Habitats Regulations', is required.
