





















Fig.39 Building Height in Dublin Context






Fig.17 Dublin City: Historic Core






Fig.7 Retail Strategy







Fig.8 City Centre Retail Core - Principal Shopping Streets







**CONNOLLY STATION LANDS – KEY REGENERATION SITE** 














- IFSC 1987. First building delivered 1990

- Proposed new SDZ Poolbeg West 2017










## Rationale for Strategic Development Zone at Dublin Docklands


- > Economic driver for the city and state

- Consolidation of the city antidote to sprawl


