
#### **Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments**

There are 209,941 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 97,432 are female and 112,419 are male.



The sector with the highest number of people in receipt of the Pandemic Unemployment Payment is Accommodation and Food Service Activities (45,584) followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade (30,869) and Administrative and Support Service activities (22,924).

## Analysis of People who Closed their PUP Claim to Return to Work

Around 7,629 people who have closed their account for return to work since 6<sup>th</sup> September will receive a Pandemic Unemployment Payment tomorrow,15<sup>th</sup> September. Of these, 3,281 are male and 4,348 are female.

#### **Analysis of COVID-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit**

There are 60,977 people medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment, of whom 33,833 are female and 27,144 are male.

Since September 2020, approximately 1,800 people have been medically certified for meeting the conditions for receipt of a Covid-19 Enhanced Illness Benefit payment and almost 80 of these being diagnosed with the Covid-19 coronavirus.
