## PART II : SANITARY INFORMATION

I the undersigned Official Veterinarian hereby certify that :

### Country of Origin

1. Ireland is free from Foot and Mouth Disease, Lumpy Skin Disease, Pest de Petits Ruminants, Vesicular Stomatitis, Rabies, Anthrax and Bluetongue.
2. Ireland is officially free from *Brucella melitensis* and *Brucellosis abortus*. There have been no reported cases of *Brucella ovis* during the last three years.
3. No cases of *Mycoplasma Agalactiae* have ever been recorded in Ireland.
4. The feeding of ruminants with meat and bone meal derived from animals is prohibited and this measure is effectively applied according to European Community rules.

### The Farms of Origin

5. There have been no cases of scrapie officially recorded on the farms of origin during the last six years.
6. The farms of origin have not had Tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium Bovis*) confirmed in cattle or sheep at the time of export.

### The exported animals

7. The animals have been reared in the country of origin since their birth and do not come from countries not authorised by Qatar.
8. The animals have been isolated from other sheep not of the same health status for at least 21 days prior to export.
9. The animals have been identified with an electronic tag set bearing identification numbers which are attached to the health certificate.
10. The animals are not to be slaughtered under any disease eradication programme.
11. The animals have not been vaccinated against bluetongue.
12. The animals were treated against internal and external parasites during isolation with .....(name of treatment).
13. The animals were examined on the day of loading and did not show any signs of contagious or infectious diseases.
14. The animals have been loaded onto cleaned and disinfected means of transport at the place of isolation/ place of assembly<sup>1</sup> for direct transfer to the port or airport of departure without contact with animals of a lower health status.
