
Analysis of Pandemic Unemployment Payments

There are 205,593 people in receipt a Pandemic Unemployment Payment of which 94,961 are female and 110,362 are male.



To date, 69,266 people have been medically certified for receipt of a Covid-19 related Illness Benefit payment, of whom 38,374 are female and 30,892 are male.
